land*

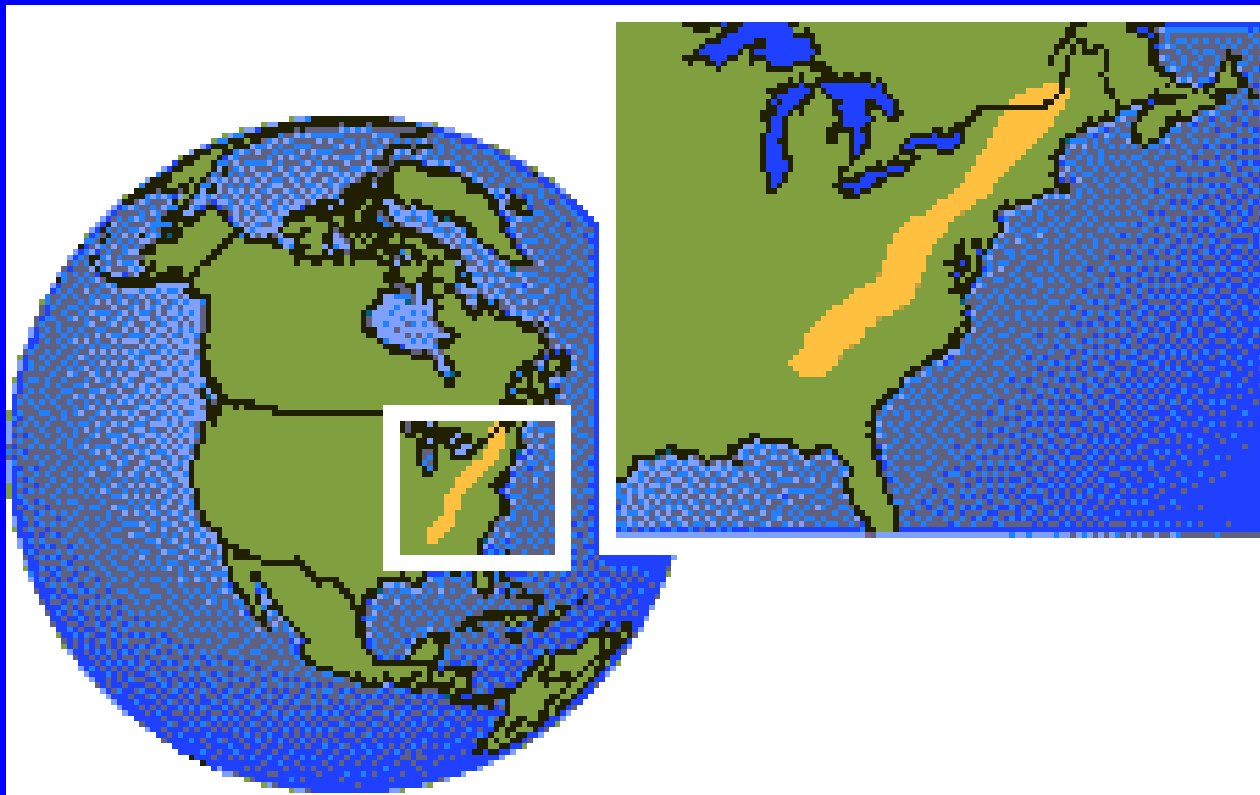

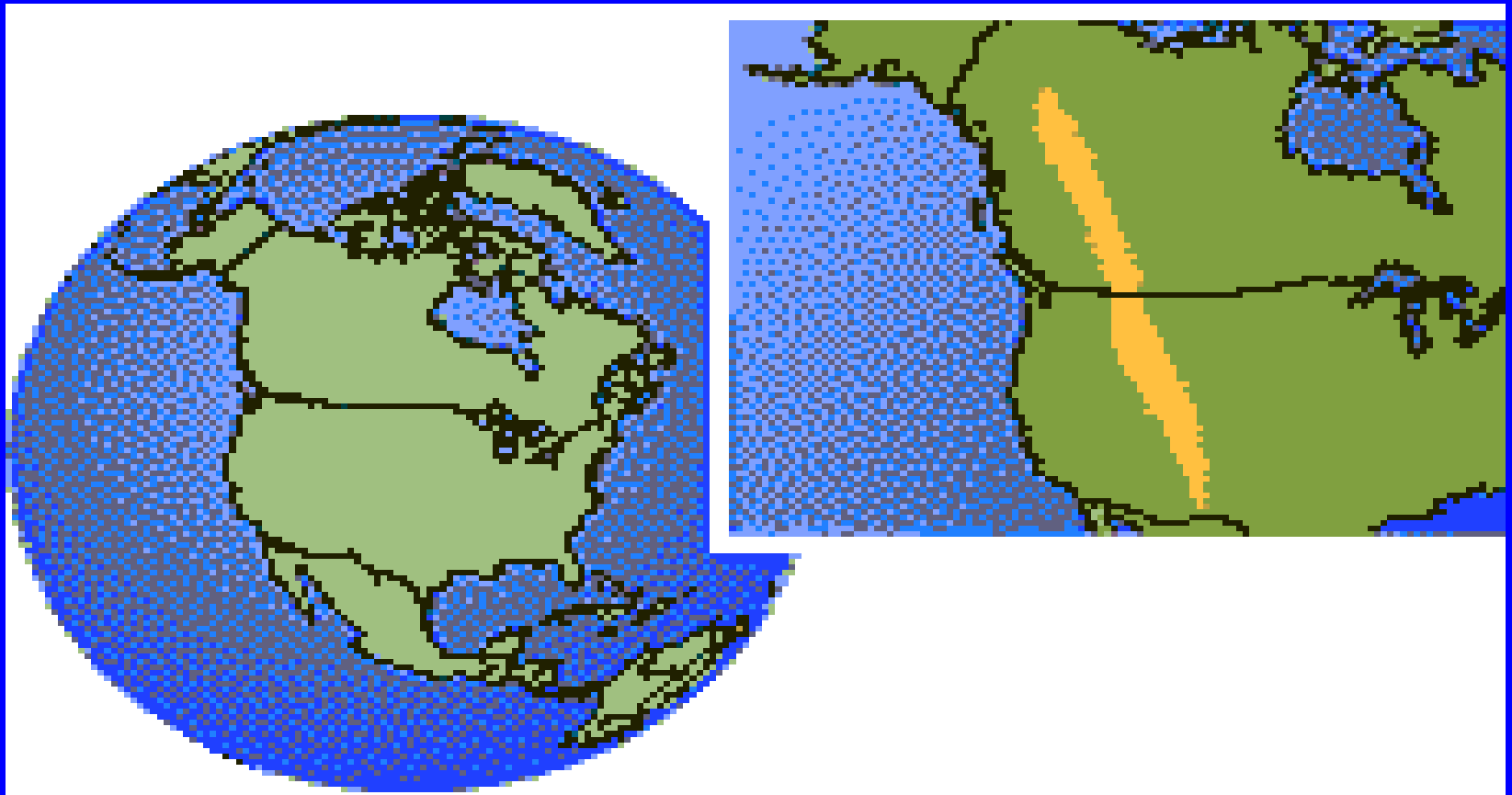
Genesis 49:25-26

- They extend from Alaska to the tip of South America

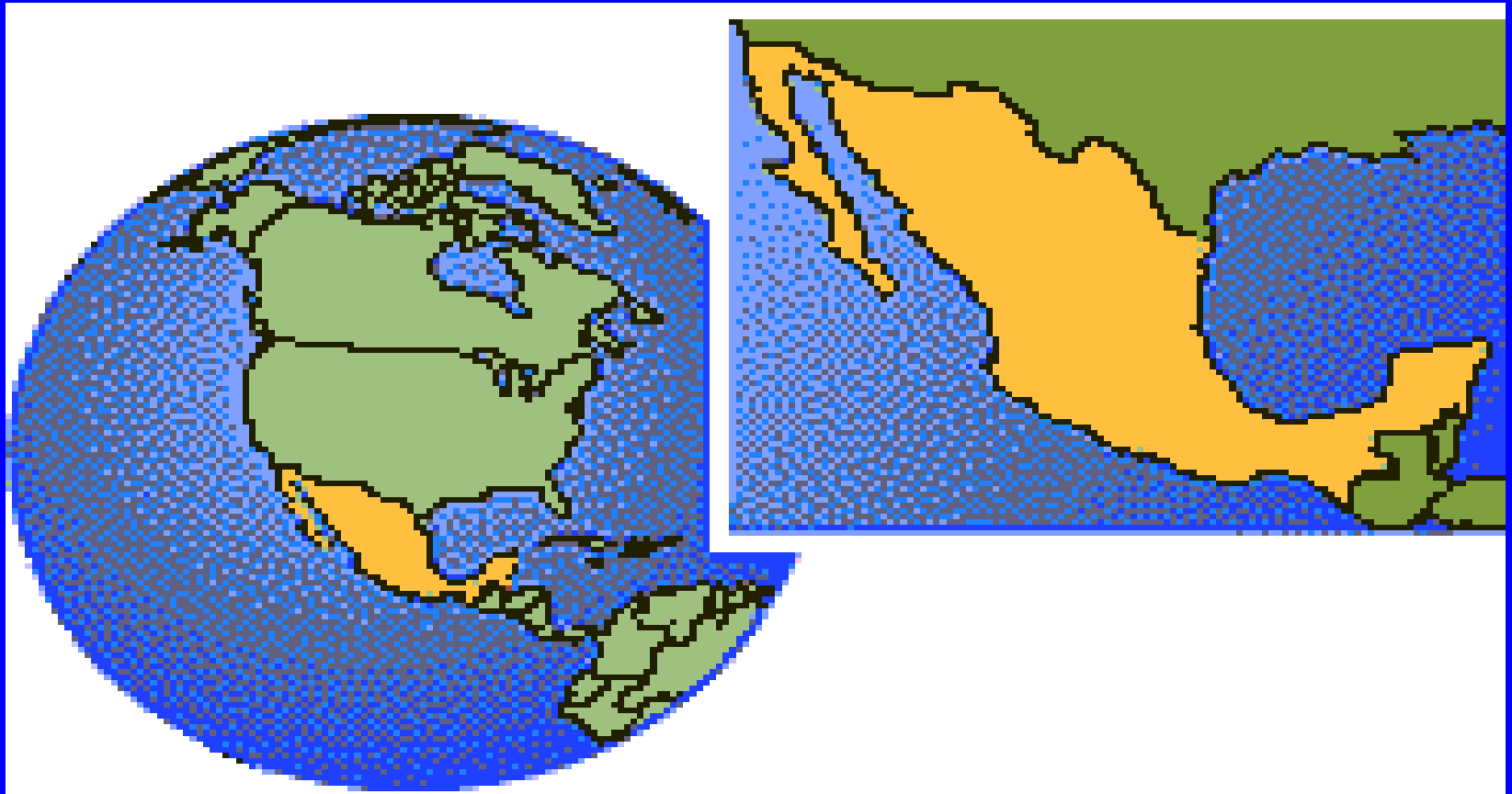
