Abraham and Sarah-Lesson 2

Read: Re-read the story "The Three Visitors" and "Isaac's Birth" in <u>The</u> Beginner's Bible.

Discuss: This story shows us two miracles of God's power. Seeing angels is a miracle, as well as Sarah having a baby when she was 90 years old!

- 1. What is a miracle? A wonderful work of God.
- 2. What other miracles can you think of? Jesus made a blind person see, Jesus walked on water, The creation of the world, the sixteen glowing stones, touched by the finger of the Lord... just to name a few.

Suggested Service Project (s):

Project #1: "Isaac Hats"

Materials needed: Crayola fabric markers, plain, unprinted newborn hats, small shipping box

Directions:

- 1.Decorate infant hats with the fabric markers.
- 2. Let kids place the hats into a small shipping box.
- 3. Send or bring them to a local hospital, women's shelter, etc.

Project #2: "Sarah Baskets"

Materials needed: Small baskets, miscellaneous new baby items, tissue paper, colored paper, markers, stickers

Directions:

- 1. Let kids arrange tissue paper inside each basket.
- 2. Let kids place the new baby items inside each basket.
- 3. Have older kids make "congratulations" cards for each basket, and copy a Bible verse inside of it, such as: "Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for

such is of the kingdom of heaven."

- 4. Littler ones can color the cards, or decorate with stickers.
- 5. When the baskets are finished, donate them to a local women's shelter.
