

## Abraham and Sarah

**Read:** “A New Home” & “The Visitors” from The Beginner’s Bible. If you are reading from a different children’s Bible, these stories cover Abraham and Sarah moving to Hebron, Abraham granting Lot the land of his choice, God blessing Abraham with land as well as telling him he would have many descendants, three angels visiting, and Isaac’s birth.

**Sing:** “Father Abraham” - If you don’t know the song and motions, go to [youtube.com](http://youtube.com) and type in “Father Abraham with lyrics and motions”. Click on the one that has the colorful rainbow in the background, with “praisinmotion.net” across it. Yes it is cheesy but it is the best one for learning this song! Have fun!

**Create:** Abraham beards.

**Materials:** Construction paper, cotton balls, string, paper puncher, glue.

### Directions:

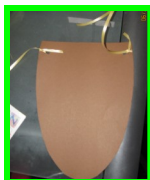
1. Print out enough beards, onto cardstock or construction paper, for your class.
2. Instruct kids to cut out beards, assisting as needed.



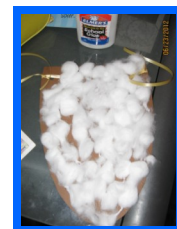
3. Punch two holes, one on each side of the beard.



4. Measure out two pieces of string, about six inches in length, for each student.
5. Help kids tie the strings onto the holes, one on each side of the beard, leaving enough string to tie them behind their heads when finished.



6. Have kids glue cotton balls onto the beards.



7. If you have enough time, sing one more round of “Father Abraham”, this time wearing the beards!

**Suggested Extension:** Sing “Father Abraham” as an offering in church.
