Narrator: Lehi and his family are on the ship sailing towards the Promised Land.

Students will be boarding in the ship.

Narrator: Strong winds blew the ship toward the promised land.

A fan will be blowing on the mast of the ship.

Narrator: Laman, Lemuel, and some of the others began being wicked. When Nephi told them to stop, they got angry and tied him up with.

Students who are playing Laman, Lemuel, and some of the women will be dancing around and Laman and Lemuel will tie up Nephi with bungee cords.

Narrator: Because of their wickedness, the Liahona stopped working. They did not know which way to steer the ship. A terrible storm blew the ship backward for three days.

The wind will blow on the ship and students will act like they are going from one side of the ship to the other.

Lehi/ Sariah and the other brothers: Untie Nephi.

Laman and Lemuel look afraid.

Narrator: Finally, Laman and Lemuel repented and untied Nephi.

Laman and Lemuel will unhook the bungee straps.

Narrator: Nephi then picked up the Liahona, and it worked again. Nephi prayed and the wind stopped. The sea became calm and Nephi steered the ship, and it sailed again toward the promised land.

Nephi will pick up the Liahona, reading what it says and take hold of the steering wheel for the ending of the play.
