Historicist

The 1/3 of mankind represents the eastern portion of the Roman Empire. The invasion was a fierce people who came from the area of the Caspian Sea. They conquered Persia, Syria and converted to Islam. They crossed the Euphrates R. in A.D. 1062 to invade the Christian empire.

It is not certain whether this army represented allies of Rome That came from the east, or whether it was a general reference to the Roman armies only. The final siege of Jerusalem In A.D. 70 is depicted by the seven bowls later in the book of Revelation.

Futurist

These four are evil angels. The destruction comes from a great army from the Orient, gathered by demonic influences.

The expression hour, day month and year, does not refer to the duration of the carnage, but to the fact that this judgment comes exactly at the time God ordained.

There are two camps with reference to the identity of these bizarre horsemen: (1) that they are demonic spirits, and (2) that they are literal armies – probably from the Orient.

"It seems clear that what John envisions for us is the machinery of modern (or future) military destruction." Another writer said "All of these things are a part of a thermonuclear war:" This may be the army of the Antichrist and possibly consist of Muslims. "The vision belongs specifically to the end of time."

The Euphrates symbolizes a "restraint upon the forces of evil." These trumpet judgments are to warn rather than destroy.
