Read: The Book of Mormon, Ether 4:63-79.

Discuss: -Why were King Lib's people blessed? They believed in the Lord and followed his commandments. "...Lib did that which was good in the sight of the Lord."

-The Lord remembers His promises! *The Lord fulfilled his promise to the Brother of Jared, that their seed would live in a land that was choice above all other lands.* 

Activity #1: Treasure hunt!! King Lib's people dug all manner of metal out of the earth, so let's simulate it:

Materials Needed: (A warm day is a must, and also access to sand!) "treasures", such as old jewelry, toys, etc.

- 1. If you do not have a sandbox, fill a large bucket with sand, and then bury the treasures!
- 2. Let the kids go on an archaeological expedition!

## **Activity #2: Clothe King Lib's people!**

Materials Needed: Construction paper, glue, googly eyes, markers, fabric scraps, with differing colors and textures, scissors.

- 1. Have kids draw a person, or people, onto the construction paper.
- 2. Let them cut out clothes for their people out of the different fabric scraps, and glue them on.
- 3. Use the googly eyes and markers for faces.
- 4. Somewhere on their paper, have them write "King Lib's people were blessed."
