Read: The Book of Mormon, Ether 4:63-79.

Discuss: -Why were King Lib's people blessed? *They believed in the Lord and followed his commandments. "...Lib did that which was good in the sight of the Lord."*

-The Lord remembers His promises! *The Lord fulfilled his promise to the Brother of Jared, that their seed would live in a land that was choice above all other lands.*

Activity #1: Treasure hunt!! King Lib's people dug all manner of metal out of the earth, so let's simulate it:

Materials Needed: (A warm day is a must, and also access to sand!) "treasures", such as old jewelry, toys, etc.

1. If you do not have a sandbox, fill a large bucket with sand, and then bury the treasures!
2. Let the kids go on an archaeological expedition!

Activity #2: Clothe King Lib's people!

Materials Needed: Construction paper, glue, googly eyes, markers, fabric scraps, with differing colors and textures, scissors.

1. Have kids draw a person, or people, onto the construction paper.
2. Let them cut out clothes for their people out of the different fabric scraps, and glue them on.
3. Use the googly eyes and markers for faces.
4. Somewhere on their paper, have them write "King Lib's people were blessed."
