

Moses– Lesson 2

Exodus 2

Read: “Prince on the Run” & “A Burning Bush!” from the Action Bible, or a comparable version.

Discuss: Any questions the kids might have about the story.

Create: A burning bush. You could either have each child make their own, or work together as a group to make a large display for the wall.

Materials: Small twigs, or branches, small or large flower pots, foam filler or rocks, craft wire or pipe cleaners, red, yellow and orange tissue paper, glue, paintbrushes, construction paper, any color except black, markers

Directions:

1. Go outside with the kids and gather several sticks no longer than 12 inches. The more twisted, and the more little branch-offs they have, the better. Each kid should gather at least three sticks: one largest for the main part of their bush, and at least two smaller ones for branch-offs.
2. Inside, the kids put whatever filler you have into the pots.
3. Insert the main branch, standing upright.
4. Attach the other smaller branches with the pipe cleaner.
5. Tear the tissue paper into small pieces, and glue them to the branches.
6. Write “I Am that I Am” on a piece of construction paper.
7. Cut around the writing, and glue it to the pot.

Extension: Suggest the kids to watch the movie at home, “The Prince of Egypt.” It is such a beautiful depiction of the story of Moses.
