
The Nephites Joined by the Mulekites

"Finding the Land of Zarahemla" & "King Benjamin" Omni & Mosiah

Read: A Thumbnail Sketch of the Book of Mormon, by Apostle Brian E. McIndoo and Marlene Oar, pgs. 28-30, "Finding the Land of Zarahemla" and "King Benjamin."

Discuss: The people of Zarahemla were Mulekites. Mulek, who was the son of King Zedekiah, the king of Judah at the time of Lehi, had taken a group of people and escaped soon after Lehi and his family left. They landed in the land north of Lehi. (See attached map.)

Activity: Make a cartoon strip of this story in chronological order. You may use the attached blank one which includes narration.



King Mosiah takes believers and flees into the wilderness.	They find a new land, called Zarahemla. The Mulekites lived there. They didn't have the word of God.
King Benjamin becomes king. He was righteous.	King Benjamin teaches the people of Zarahemla to live righteously. The people made a covenant to serve God all of their lives.
