Symbolism and Prophetic Language

Amos 3: 7 Surely the Lord GOD will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets.

(In the language of the prophets, symbolism is the rule, literalism is the exception. The prophets and the Scriptures should be the source for defining prophetic language.)

Number **1** – Signifies unity, only divisible by itself. Represents the oneness or absolute unity of God in the Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

Number 2 – Conveys the meaning of a union such as a man and a woman or Christ and the Church; also, is a number of division or the verification of facts by witnesses. (*Deut. 17:6, 19:15, Matt 18:16*)

Number **3** – Signifies Deity (*Matt. 28:18; 2Ne. 13:32*)

Number **4** - Signifies all of creation. used in reference to the 4 winds, (Dan. 7:2); 4 corners of the earth; creatures each with 4 wings and 4 faces (Ez. 1:5); 4 rivers of Paradise (Gen. 2:10) 4 beasts, (Dan 7:1; Rev 4:6)

Number **5** - Signifies punishment, appearing as legal requirements (*Ex. 22:1; Lev. 5:16; 22:14; Num. 5:7, 18:16*) and the five division of empires in Dan 2)

Number 6 – Signifies man and human weakness. Man created on the 6th day and appointed to labor for 6 days because of his transgression.

Number **7** – Completeness and perfection both spiritually and physically being 3 plus 4. Seven days completed the week. (*Gen* 4:24)

Number **10** – A preferential number is exemplified in the Ten Commandments and the law of tithe. Ten is also viewed as a complete and perfect number, as is 3, 7 and 12. It is made up of 4, the number of the physical creation, and 6, the number of mankind.

Number 12 – Perfect number being a multiple of 3 and 4. Found in scripture, 12 tribes, 12 stones in the high priests' breastplate, 12 apostles, 12 foundation-stones, and 12 gates. (Rev 21:19-21)

Number **24** – Number associated with Priesthood; number of priests that served in the Temple (1Chron. 24), number of Elders around the throne of God (Rev. 4:4 & 10; 5:8&14; 11:16; 19:4) and is a multiple of 3, 4 and 12.

Number **70 –** A compound of 7 and 10

Number 666 – Number of the beast (Rev. 13:18)

Number **1,000** – Immensity and fullness, how long Satan will be bound, time when Christ reign upon the earth before the resurrection (*Rev. 20:1-6*)

Abominable Church – Catholic Church, spiritual Babylon, whore of the earth, churches not part of the Church of Lamb (1Ne. 3:222, 7:26, Rev. 17:5)

Anti-Christ – Deceiver (1Jn 2:18 & 22, 4:3; 2Jn 1:7)

Armageddon – Hill of rendezvous (Rev. 16:16)

Babylon - Pagan, worldly, proud, arrogant, insolent, oppressive, apostate church (Rev. 14:8; 17:5, 18:2-3)

Balances & Scales, pair of – Denotes equity, justice, taxation, oppression (Rev. 6:5-6)

Bear – a) powerful but inferior to the lion **b)** Media-Persia (Dan. 7)

Beasts – a) a living thing (*Rev 5:6, 15:7*); b) Huge, Domineering, great things (*Dan. 7:3*) c) Dangerous, venomous, wild agents of Satan's plans (*Rev. 13:2, 20:10*)

Black (horse) - Famine, pestilence, taxation, invasion (Rev. 6:5-6)

Bottomless pit – Where Satan and his agents are confined (Rev. 9:2 & 11, 20:1-3)

Bow, holding – Represents a warrior, one with power over others (Gen. 48:22, 49:24)

Calf, face of - (a Young Bull) - Strength, endurance (Rev. 4:7)

Candlestick – Churches, witness (Rev. 1:20, Rev. 11:4)

Chariots – a vehicle, any apparatus of war (Zach. 6:1; Rev. 9:9; 3Ne 9:101)

Crown/s - a) Victorious (Rev. 3:11, 1Pt. 5:4, 2Tim 4:8, Zech. 9:16, Isa. 62:3,1Corth. 9:25) b) Leaders (Rev 3:11)

Crowns, seven – the seven admirative heads of the empire though history are 1) Kings 2) Consuls 3) dictatorship 4) decemvirs 5) tribunes 6) emperors, 7) Exarchs (a Bishop)

Day - Year (Numb. 14:33-34; Ez.4:6)

Dividing of times – Half a year (Dan. 12:7; Rev 12:14)

Dragon - Satan (Rev. 12:4,9)

Eagles – a) Swiftness, strength (Ex.19:4; 2Sam. 1:23; Jer. 4:13; Isa. 30:17); b) Devourers and judgment (Birds of prey – parallel with fowl - Rev.19:17-18, 21; Matt. 24:28; Lk. 17:37)

Earthquakes – Political and cultural upheaval, revolution (Rev. 6:12-17)

Eyes, full of – Vision, insight, envy (Rev. 4:6)

Face of a Man – Intelligence (Rev. 4:7)

False Prophet, A – One that teaches untruths as God's word (Acts 13:6, Hel 5:36) See also anti-christ.

False Prophet, The – Mohammed, Islam (Rev. 16:13, 19:20, 20:10)

Forty and two months – 1260 years (*Rev. 11:2; 13:5*)

Fowl – Devourers and judgment (Birds of prey parallel with eagles- Rev. 19:17-18, 21; Matt. 24:28; Lk. 17:37)

Frogs, spirits like – Toxic, plagues of spiritual destruction (Rev. 16:13-14; 1Jn 4:1-3)

Glass - Calm, Peace, Stability

Gog - Turkey, Iran, Iraq (Medes and Persians)

Hail – God's vengeance (Ps 18:13; Rev 8:7, 11:19)

Harlots – Apostate churches (Rev. 17:5, 1Ne.3:183)

Head wounded – Destruction of empire anticipated

Heads – Leaders (Rev. 12:3)

Heads, seven – the seven hills on which Rome sits (Rev. 17:9)

Horn – Kings, ruler (Dan. 7:24; Rev. 17:12)

Horns, ten – the ten parts of Rome which broke off and had a king over each part. (Dan. 2:34, Rev 12:3, 13:1, 17:7)

Horse – Warfare, fleetness, strength (Prov. 21:31; Zech. 10:3)

Hunger – famine accompanied with warfare (Rev. 6:8)

Kill one another – Internal chaos, strife, bloodshed (Rev. 6)

Kings of the East - Enemies to Christianity, predominately countries of pagan religions i.e.: Muslim, Hindu, Buddhist etc. (*Rev.* 16:12-14)

Lake of fire and brimstone – Hell, second death, eternal punishment (Rev. 20:10, 2Ne. 6:54)

Lamb – Jesus Christ, Messiah (1Ne. 3:119)

Leopard – a) Furious, rapid attack **b)** Greece (Dan. 7)

Lion – a) Brave, furious, dominion, authority **b)** Babylon (*Dan.7*)

Little Horn – Papacy (*Dan.7:25*)

Locusts – National entities from the East – Muslim (Rev. 9:3,7)

Magog – Turkey, and area around the Black Sea, Followers of Islam

Man child – Kingdom of Heaven (Rev. 12:5)

Man of Sin – Anti-Christ, Man of sin, Little Horn, Papacy (2Thess. 2:3-10; Dan. 7: 8, 24-25, Rev. 13:7)

Mark of the Beast – Cult of the Cross (Rev. 19:20, 20:4)

Martyr – Witness (Both are the same Greek word Strong's G3134 - Acts 21:22, 22:20; Rev. 3:14)

Megiddo – Rendezvous, assembly (Joel 3:2,14)

Moon – Old Covenant – reflects the light of truth to come and is the foundation of all truth. (Rev. 12:1)

Mountains and Islands – Religious strongholds, private kingdoms to be shaken at Christ's return.

Nourished – Fatten, cherish, pamper, rear, bring up, feed; (*Strong's # 5142 and is the same word as used in Rev. 12:14; James 5:5; Acts 12:20; Matt.25:37,6:26; Lk 12:24, 4:16*)

Oil & wine, – Luxury items (Rev. 6:6, 18:12-13)

Olive trees - Tribes of the House of Israel

Pale, horse - associated with death, pestilence and famine

Peace, take away – Bloodshed, preplace peace with discord (Rev. 6:4)

Plea for rocks to fall – Awful fear upon the land (Rev. 6:16; Al. 9:25)

Price of grain - Denotes scarcity (Rev. 6:6)

Purple – Royalty (*Jn. 19:2; Rev. 18:16*)

Red – Denotes bloodshed, carnage and discord (Rev. 6:4, 12:3)

River Euphrates - God's protective barrier which holds back the enemies of Christianity (Rev. 16:12)

Rod – Standard of Measurement, Gospel of Truth (Rev:11:1)

Rod of Iron – Word of God (Rev. 12:5; 19:15; 1Ne. 3:68)

Sackcloth – Mourn, mortify, death (Rev. 11:30)

Scarlet – Royalty (Rev. 18:16)

Scorpion – Inflicting great pain and suffering (Rev. 9:3,10)

Sea – Nations of People (Rev. 13:1)

Sea of Blood – War, great battles at sea (Rev. 16:3)

Sea of Glass – stability, peace, majesty, dominion (Rev. 14:6, 15:2)

Sea, out of – Multitudes of nations and tongues (Rev. 13)

Seal – a signet, stamp or mark of privacy, fencing in or protection from misappropriation (Dan. 9:24; Rev. 6:3-12, 9:4, 20:3)

Seat of the Beast – Holy Roman Empire (Rev. 13:2, 16:10)

Serpent – Satan, the Devil (Rev. 12:9, 20:2)

Seven candlesticks – The seven churches of Asia (Rev 2)

Seven spirits of God – Lamps of Fire, consume, burn and light (*Rev. 3:1, 4:5, 5:6*)

Smoke – Power from; the presence and Glory of God (Ex. 19:8; Isa 6:3-4; Rev 15:8)

Stars – a) Ministerial leaders in God's hand (Rev. 1:20, 2:1, 12:1) b) Angels (Rev. 12:4) c) Heavenly bodies that are part of God's creation denoting an immeasurable number (Heb. 11:12)

Strait Gate - Repentance and baptism (Matt. 7:13-14, 2Ne13:23-25)

Sun – a) New Covenant made through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ (Rev. 12:1) b) Jesus Christ – light in a dark world (Mal.4:12)

Sun, Moon & Stars, signs – Earthly dignitaries, Political figures (Joel 2:10 & 31, 3:15; Isa. 13:9-10, 24:23, 30:26; Rev. 6:12-17)

Sword - Authority, bloodshed, slaughter, looking for war (Deut. 33:29; Josh. 11:11; Isa. 66:16; Rev.1:16, 6:6; 3Ne. 9:56-57)

Ten Horns – Roman Empire (Dan. 7)

Ten Toes – Subordinate Kingdoms of Rome (Dan. 2)

Third Part – Not to mean 33 1/3% but a portion(presumably a lesser portion) a) Old Test. Offering to God (*Numb 15:6-7*), b) The Prophets- used as Judgement (*Ez.5:1-2*), c) Revelation of Christ -Judgement (*Rev. 8:11-12, 9:18, 12:4*)

Thousand two hundred and threescore days – 1260 Years (Rev. 11:3; 12:6)

Three days and a half – 1260 years (Rev. 11:9)

Thunder and lightning - Power of God (Job 28:26; Matt. 24:27; Lk. 17:24; Rev. 11:19; Hel. 5:81-82)

Time - One Year (Dan. 12:7; Rev 12:14)

Time, times and dividing of time – 1260 Years (Dan. 12:7; Rev 12:14)

Times – Two years (Dan. 12:7; Rev 12:14)

Towers – Strongholds, fortification of city (Isa. 30:25; Ez. 26:9; Zeph. 1:16, 3:6)

Vial – shallow cup of uncertain affinity, relationship towards something (Rev. 16:2-17)

Vials – God' wrath and judgement (Rev. 16:1)

Wall - The sea (Gen. 49:22; Ps. 80:1-2; Ex. 19:22; Nahum 3:8)

White – Purity, innocent, prosperity, triumph

White Linen - Righteousness (parallel with robes and raiment - (Rev. 3:5 & 18, 6:11, 7:9, 13-14, 19:8; 1Ne. 2:44)

White raiment - Righteousness (parallel with robes and linen Rev. 3:5 &18, 6:11, 7:9, 13-14, 19:8; 1Ne. 2:44)

White Robes - Righteousness (parallel with linen and raiment - Rev. 3:5 &18, 6:11, 7:9, 13-14, 19:8; 1Ne. 2:44)

Wife - Bride, Christ's church (Rev. 19:7)

Wilderness – Place of punishment, judgement, away from God (Numb. 14:33, 32:1; Isa. 14:17; Hosea 2:3; Rev. 12:6)

Wind – Wars, commotions, tumults (Rev. 6:13, 7:1)

Winepress – God's wrath (Rev. 19:15)

Wings – Speed and ability to conquer

Wings; two – Catholic and Orthodox; Eastern and Western Rome (Rev. 12:14)

Woman – A Church (Rev. 12)

Wormwood - Bitterness, calamity, cursed (Deut. 29:18; Jer. 9:15; Amos 5:7; Rev. 8:11)
