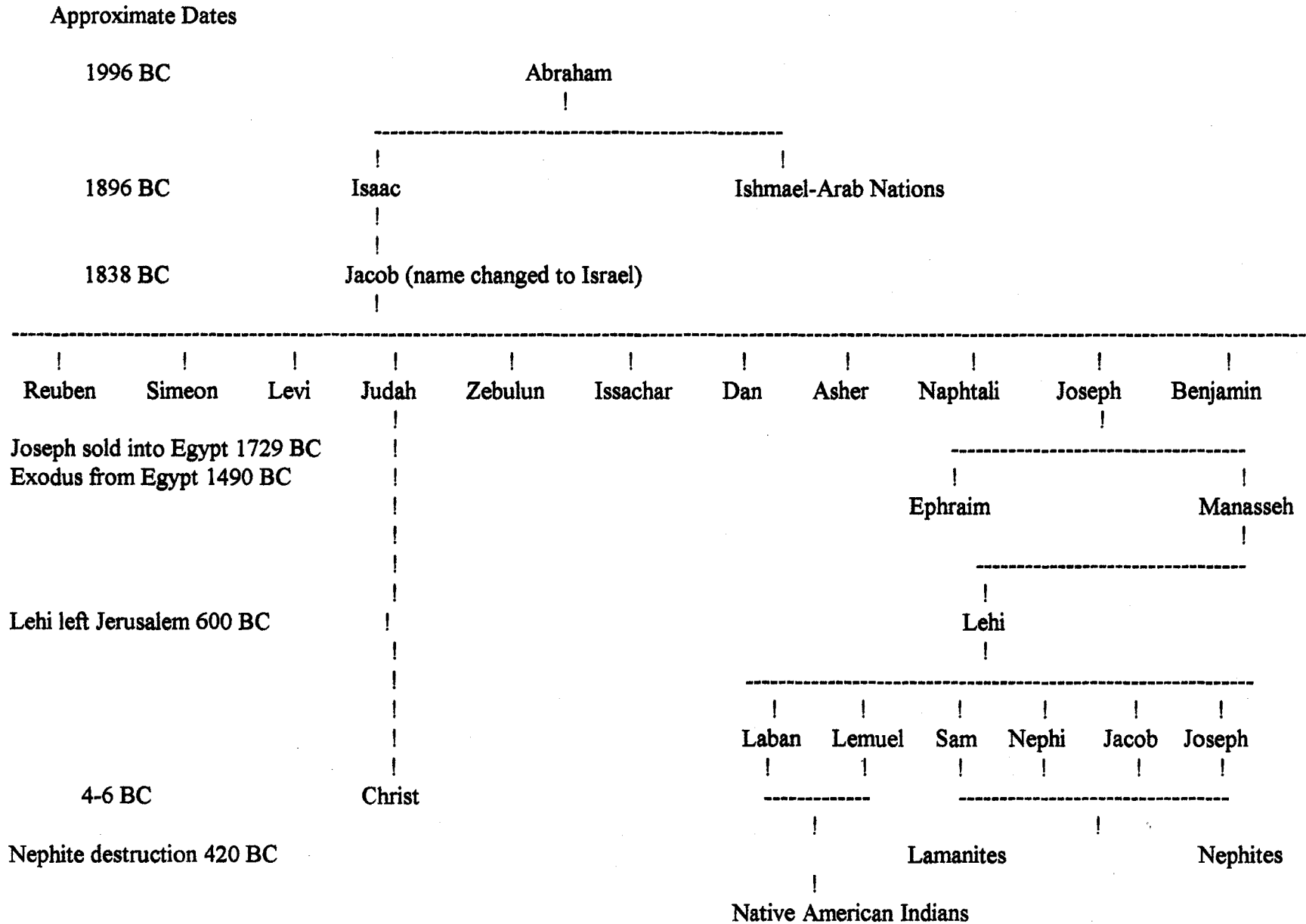


THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL



Genesis 11:10-

Abraham: Born around 2000-1990 BC in the land of Ur the son of Terah and was 9th generation of Shem, Noah's son. Ur is what would be modern day Iraq near the Tigris and Euphrates rivers near the Persian Gulf.

Abram took Sarai as his wife and they moved from Ur and lived in the land of Heran. Heran was about half way from Ur to the land of Canaan (modern day Israel and surrounding countries)

Abram was commanded by God to go to the land of Canaan and the promise was made to him that through him all the nations would be blessed. This was in reference to Christ being born through his seed. Abram left Haran when he was 75 years old.

Genesis 13:14-17 Abram told that the Lord would give the land for his inheritance.

Genesis 16 Abraham has a son by Sarai's handmaiden. Ishmael became the father of the Arab nations

Genesis 17 Abram name changed to Abraham and told he would be the father of many nations. Sarai's name changed to Sarah. Promised he would have a son and his name would be Isaac. Abraham means "father of many" Sarah means "princess"

Genesis 21 Isaac born. Isaac means "he laughs"

Genesis 22 Abraham takes Isaac to offer him to the Lord

Genesis 25:26 Jacob born. Jacob means "heel catcher" or "trickster" or "supplanter". Jacob is the father of 12 sons (the 12 tribes of Israel).

Joseph the 11th son of Jacob. Sold into Egypt. Father of Ephraim and Manasseh. The younger son, Ephraim, gets the greater blessing. Genesis 48:8

Lehi a descendant of Manasseh

Alma 8:3 And Aminadi was a descendant of Nephi, who was the son of Lehi, who came out of the land of Jerusalem, who was a descendant of Manasseh, who was the son of Joseph, who was sold into Egypt by the hands of his brethren.

Lehi was led to the Americas 600 BC (1 Nephi 1:3)

The Bible (stick of Judah) is a record of the Jewish people

The Book of Mormon (stick of Joseph) is a record of the Native Americans

The Lord calls to Abram Genesis 12:1-7

Abram means "exalted father", he was born around 2100-2000 BC. In Genesis 17:5 we find his name was changed to Abraham "father of many".

He lived in Ur about 200 miles south east of Bagdad. Only 2 routes were to Canaan were available. One across the Arabian Desert, which would have been impossible to take large herds across. The other was along the Euphrates River, about 1500 miles.
