Sion - A mountain the northern most border of Israel

- Josh 12:1 Now these are the kings of the land, which the children of Israel smote, and possessed their land on the other side Jordan toward the rising of the sun, from the river Arnon unto mount Hermon, and all the plain on the east:
- Deu 4:48 From Aroer, which is by the bank of the river Arnon, even unto mount <u>Sion</u>, which is Hermon,

Mt. Hermon - (sacred mountain); mt. marking South terminus of Anti-leboanon range; 30 miles SW of Damascus; 9,000 ft. above sea level; marks North boundry of Palestine; Probably mt. of transfiguation (Matt. 17:1). Seat of Baal worship (Judg 3:3).

Gen 22:2 And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.

Zion - The city of David

2 Sam 5:6-7 And the king and his men <u>went to Jerusalem unto the Jebusites</u>, the inhabitants of the land: which spake unto David, saying, Except thou take away the blind and the lame, thou shalt not come in hither: thinking, David cannot come in hither. Nevertheless David took the strong hold of **Zion**: the same is <u>the city of David</u>.

Zion - The area where Solomon built the Temple

- 2 Chr 3:1 Then Solomon began to build the house of the Lord <u>at Jerusalem in mount Moriah</u>, where the Lord appeared unto David his father, in the place that David had prepared in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 1 Chr 21:18 Then the angel of the Lord commanded Gad to say to David, that David should go up, and set <u>up an altar unto the Lord in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite</u>.

Zion - The protected land for the people of God

Zec 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of **Zion**; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Strong's number: 6726 Hebrew: Tsiyown Pronunciation: tsee-yone'; Tsijon (as a permanent capital), a mountain of Jerusalem: --Zion.

Mat 21:5 Tell ye the daughter of <u>Sion</u>, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

Strong's number: 4622 Greek: Sion Pronunciation: see-own' of Hebrew origin [6726]; Sion (i.e. Tsijon), a hill of Jerusalem; figuratively, the Church (militant or triumphant): --Sion.

- Psa 133:1-3 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! <u>Joseph</u>, for which things there has been a type; for as Joseph brought his father down into the land of Egypt, even so he died there; Wherefore the Lord brought a remnant of the seed of Joseph out of the land of Jerusalem, that he might be merciful unto the seed of Joseph, that they should perish not, even as he was merciful unto the father of Joseph, that he should perish not; Wherefore the remnant of the house of Joseph shall be built up upon this land; and it shall be a land of their inheritance; and they shall build up a holy city unto the Lord, like unto the Jerusalem of old; and they shall no more be confounded, until the end come, when the earth shall pass away.
